Dr Galloway is the medical leader for the pain/palliative consult service at TBCC and co-lead of the CCA provincial palliative team. Prior to this, he worked as a family physician in both rural and urban settings for 7 years and then completed a fellowship in palliative medicine at U of C starting in 2001. He was Medical Director of the Intensive Palliative Care Unit at Foothills Hospital for 11 years before moving to TBCC in 2014 to establish the service there. He trained in psychedelic-assisted therapy and research with CIIS in 2019-2020 and has been involved with the majority of Alberta patients approved for psychedelic-assisted therapy in the palliative care setting to date.
